First Quarter 2022

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Introduction 2022 is well underway, and we are filled with joy and anticipation with the direction of this year. Since moving to a co-directorship, we have been able to have clearer focus on both fundraising initiatives and expanding our reintegration services abroad. Some highlights from the first quarter:

- Graduated 7 women from our Salvadoran program am:
 - More than doubled the number of women in our Costa Rican program
 - Have identified and are creating additional resources including women's health curriculum and parenting class for mothers transitioning out of prostitution
 - Welcomed 6 new women into our Mozambican program and are preparing for at least 10 graduating at the end of this year
 - Incorporated new selling experiences in El Salvador that expand the women's ability for future job holdings

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- Reopening FTG Uganda with repatriation assistance and cohosting an anti-trafficking conference in Kampala with the US Embassy and other key stakeholders
- Finishing up exploration into opening FTG Honduras
- · Welcoming the first women into the FTG Mexico project
- Finalizing our new trauma-informed, culturally appropriate job skills courses (3 of them!)
- · Have diversified our income avenues by accepting both cryptocurrency and stocks which has brought in an additional +\$50k
- Begun our relaunch of our partnerships with Hanes and Aerie
- Fundraising Expanded our church partnerships by creating additional resources for churches to engage around anti-trafficking issues
